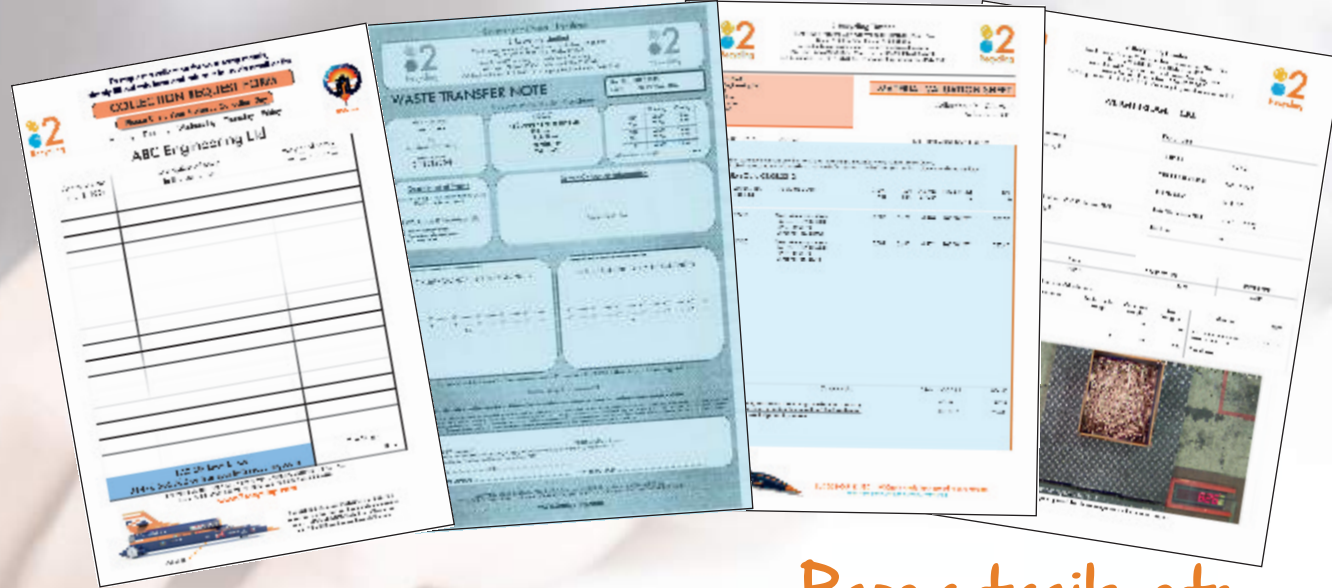

We are fully registered with the Environment Agency as well as the local Council for handling scrap metals.

We are required to observe many conditions as a part of our licensing, including storing all metal on an impermeable surface ensuring no contaminants can enter the ground. You can be assured that our commitment to all matters concerning Environmental Compliance is of the highest standard, and is demonstrated through our ISO 14001 accreditation.

We also reject any gate trade to make sure that all metal we buy only comes from registered companies (B2B) and is therefore fully traceable.

You can download copies of all of our licences such as our Scrap Metal Dealers Act 2013 Certificate, our Waste Carrier/Broker/Dealer Licence, and all of our current site licences from our website.

In addition to our Environmental ISO we have also gained ISO-9001 and OHSAS-18001,

demonstrating a commitment to quality procedures and all matters concerning Health & Safety. Should you need, we can even have our EHS Manager visit your site to produce bespoke method statements and safe working procedures, ensuring we are always safe when working on your site.

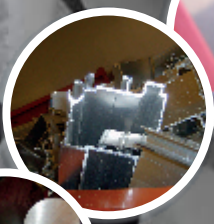
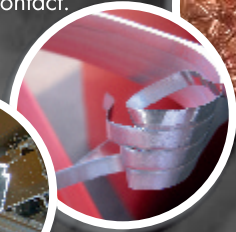

Plastic storage containers

Our range of leak-proof plastic bins are designed to prevent cutting fluids from escaping out onto your factory floor. With legislation becoming more stringent we have a solution which helps you tidy up your works and prevent spills. We have small handy sized bins for tight corners, and larger bins to fit directly under your machines.

What do we do with the liquid when it gets back to our warehouse?

We have in place a draining system for all plastic bins. This ensures we remove the fluids from the scrap, and enables us to send the fluid via a specialist disposal route for oil recovery/fluid disposal. No more worries for you.

Metal storage containers

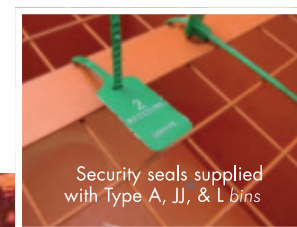
At **2 Recycling** we have an innovative approach to problems caused by storing lots of scrap metal storage containers on your site. We supply fully collapsible containers, designed to flat pack when not in use. The containers are very robust and offer the great advantage of taking up much less space when they are empty. These unique containers will still stack up to four high when full.

Another key feature of the **2 Recycling** bins is that they sit lower to the ground compared to more commonly used skips, which can help with your company's Health and Safety practices by preventing employees having to lift scrap too high to get it into the scrap metal containers/skids. We now also have a range of sealed metal bins which can be used for extra security or for wet swarf types.

We can manufacture bins to bespoke sizes at no extra cost should we not have a size that is suitable.

Skips & Special Security Skips

Where smaller bins do not work we can supply a range of open or closed (security) skips. These can be especially useful when a customer needs a safe and secure way of storing the scrap outside of their works. To ensure that your scrap is kept safe from prying eyes and also kept dry and free from rain, one of the best solutions is to use one of our security skips.

The **2 Recycling** security skips are strong and robust with a metal lid which can be locked into place. Our skips also have rear locking doors so that you can completely fill all of the skip, thus maximising transport loads which help keep your environmental impact to a minimum.

We supply our security skips with a special lid opening key & full instructions to ensure you can open the lid safely without any risk or harm to the operator.

Open or fully lockable skips - sizes available:

- 6 cubic yard - open
- 10 cubic yard - open
- 12 cubic yard - open

Collecting your scrap

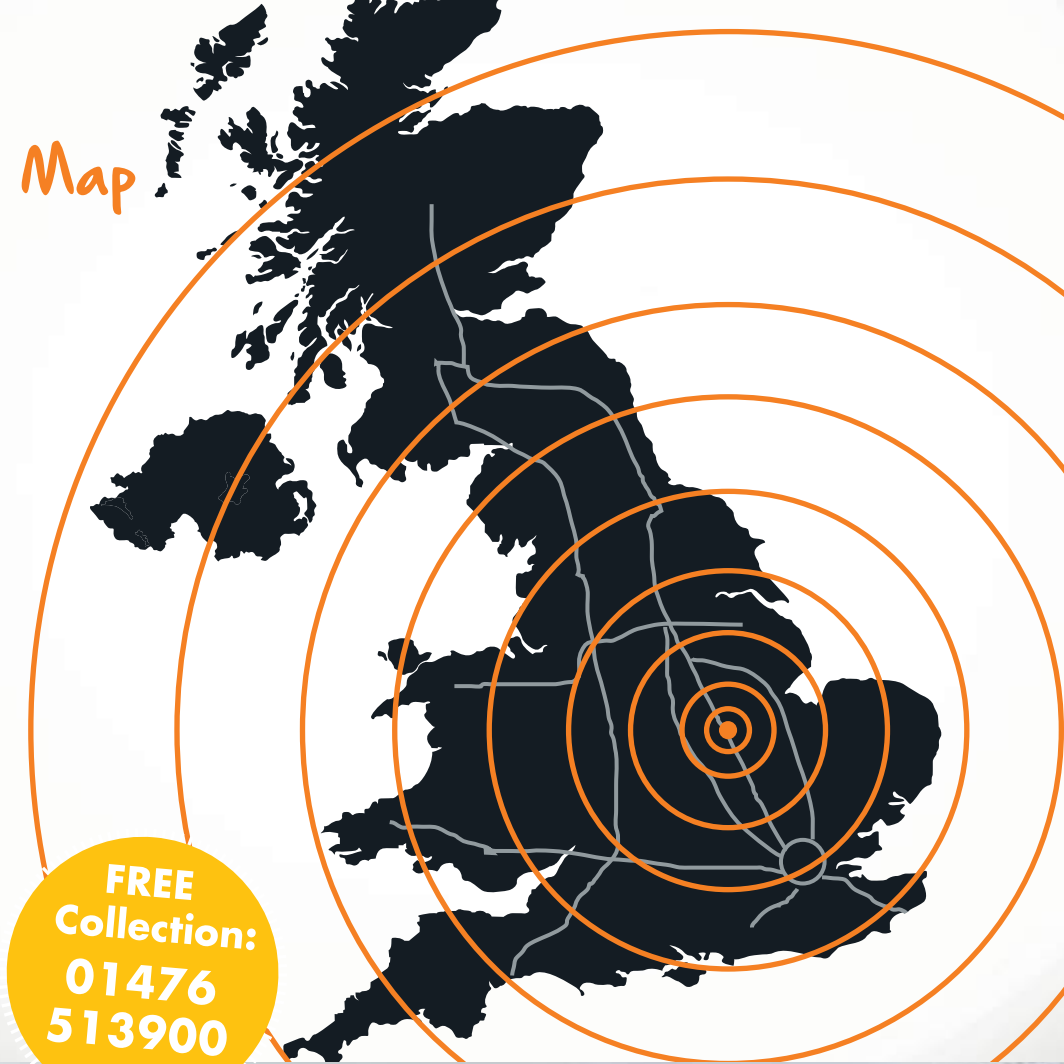
We take a lot of time and trouble to ensure that when it comes to collecting your scrap our service is always professional and very prompt, typically the next working day.

Selling your scrap metals to **2 Recycling** means our dedicated transport team arranges, controls and collects it from you using our own fleet of vehicles. We are continuously investing in our fleet to ensure we have the capability to match our promises, wherever you are in the UK.

All vehicles are tracked for added peace of mind, and we have some vehicles which carry their own forklift with them so that we can even load our own vehicles when we get to your site.

Metal Sorting

All bins are weighed & then checked by our experienced staff members so we can grade the material correctly. This grade is checked against all known grades we get from the customer to ensure it is a grade we are expecting, anything unusual gets isolated pending further investigation and testing. Should a material be contaminated then we have robust procedures in place to advise the customer before proceeding.



We have invested over the years in some of the latest portable x-ray spectrometers to enable us to accurately grade metals, and sometimes when our customers have mixed bins of different grades of metals we can provide a detailed sort report detailing every metal type found in any particular bin.



Certificates of Destruction

When you have some scrap metal or surplus stock which cannot ever come back onto the market as a usable item, we offer an extra service which destroys the item and makes sure it can never be used again. Once the process is complete we issue a Certificate of Destruction for you to keep. This guarantees that the item has been destroyed and cannot ever be re-used in its original form.

For high security items we can arrange for you to watch as the base metal (subject to conditions), goes into the furnace and is melted, or even crushed in our new baling press so it can never be used again.

All items for destruction are witnessed by our own CCTV system, images from which we can e-mail to you as further proof of the destruction process.
